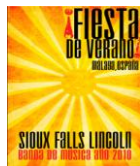


Lincoln Band Newsletter – April 2011

Let's Try A Blitz!

Saturday, April 16th – 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. or 1:00 - 3:00 p.m.

We have been given a unique fundraising opportunity – a car wash where we don't wash the cars! Soaps Up Car Wash (on the corner of 37th & Minnesota) will take care of the washing – all we have to do is sell the car wash coupons. To sell the coupons, we will have a car wash blitz on Saturday, April 16th.

How's the Blitz work? Students, in groups of 2 to 4, will sell car wash coupons in a designated area. Each student group will be accompanied/driven by a parent. Students can sign up for a time slot (10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. OR 1:00 to 3:00 p.m.) individually or in groups of 2 to 4. Each student group will be assigned an area along with an adult (parent) driver. The driver will be responsible for safely transporting the students to & from LHS. Students will **NOT** be allowed to drive for the blitz – **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

The car wash coupons are an excellent deal for everyone. The \$8.00 coupons will sell for \$7.00 each (a \$1.00 savings for the customer) or 3 for \$20.00 (a \$4.00 savings for the customer). The primary purpose of this fundraiser is to help support the general expenses of the band, however, students will also earn \$1.00 for each coupon sold for their ISA.

The sign up for students will be on the wall in the band hallway this week. Parents, please contact Mike or Madonna at mlma2@sio.midco.net or Dick or Dawn at dstanga@sio.midco.net to volunteer for the blitz. If you want to drive for your son's/daughter's group, please let us know that as well.
