Be prepared to enjoy a wonderful meal, award-winning band performance, and have the opportunity to purchase a great variety of items on the silent auction!

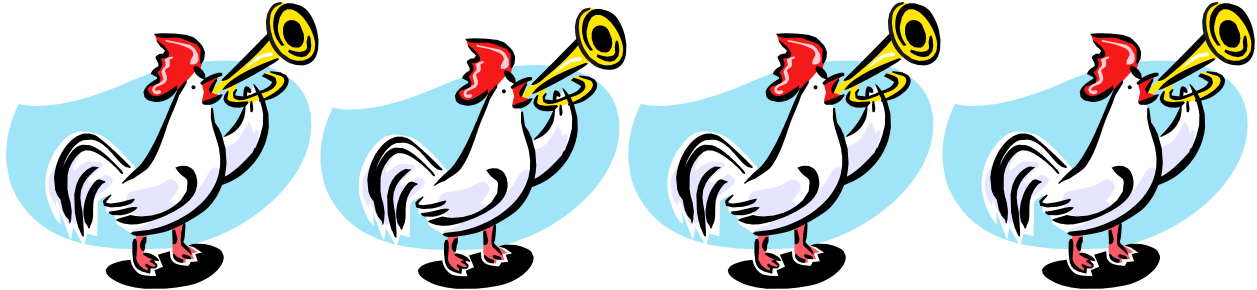
Both evenings we will have available for purchase:

The ISA Balance report on the Lincoln Band Website has been updated! You can access it at www.lincolnband.org.

Click on **Resources/ISA(Individual Student Account)/ISA Balance (October 31, 2012)**.

Each Student has two accounts. The ISA balance is current as of October 31st and includes wreath, Chicken Dinner and HyVee sales through October 31st. It does not include Raffle Ticket Sales. The TOR balance is the amount your student has paid towards the \$1200 required for the TOR Parade. If you are trying to maintain the payment schedule for the TOR account (\$125 per month) then you should have \$1100 in your TOR Account as of October 31st (\$100 down payment and \$125 for March, April, May, June, July, August, September and October). Please remember, if you have available funds in your ISA account each month for the TOR payment that is due, the ISA Treasurer will take the funds from your ISA. Payments should be made to LHS Band, and sent to Becky Stritecky, 1500 S. 4th Ave, SFSD 57105

The \$175 fundraising goal for the 2012 Marching Band Season was taken out of each ISA account on August 1, 2012, so the current balance reflects this. This is the amount that each student is asked to contribute each year to offset band expenses that the school district does not pay.

Spending Money for TOR trip

The Bandparents Association has confirmed that school district policy allows students to fundraise up to \$150 above the \$1200 for the TOR trip and receive the \$150 as spending money for the trip. This is after you have raised enough money for the trip of \$1200 and have also raised or paid the \$175 for the regular band season. Please be aware that **both** amounts have to be met before you can receive back spending money funds.

If your student will have funds available that you would like to use for spending money on the trip, attached is a form to complete to request the funds. A check will be issued to your student prior to the trip for the funds to be used on the trip. Please remember the following:

- The \$1200 TOR's fee and the \$175 regular season fee must be paid in full.
- Checks will be issued in increments of \$25 (\$25, \$50, \$75, \$100, \$125 or \$150) and will be issued to the lowest increment (if you have \$37.90 in the ISA account, a \$25 check will be issued. All checks will be issued in the student's name.
- **December 12, 2012** is the cutoff for fundraising. All fundraising through the 12th will be credited to the ISA account before checks are issued. Any fundraising after December 12th cannot be applied to the spending option.

- The check, issued in the student's name, will be mailed prior to the Christmas vacation break.
- All students are responsible for the cash once the check is cashed.

Tournament of Roses Uniform check in Procedures

Uniform Check in day is Saturday November 17, from 9:00-noon in the band room

1. Dry-clean your uniform jacket and pants; you **MUST show proof of dry cleaning.** *Tuba players must also dry clean black beret.* Vestee and sash do not need to be dry-cleaned.
2. Hang everything neatly on blue hanger with blue garment bag.
3. Put 1 or 2 clean black band t-shirts in your blue garment bag.
4. Hat box: hat, plume, gloves(1-2 pairs), gauntlets and black socks(1-2 pairs)
5. Black drillmaster band shoes: polish as needed, stuff toes with paper towels or newspapers, place in a grocery bag (we will label shoes when you check in your uniform)
6. You must have all pieces listed above in order to check in your uniform.
