The **frozen food and jewelry fundraisers began Tuesday, January 21**. Order forms were handed out during band periods. Forms are also available in the band room for students who do not have a band period

Students earn 30% of their sales for their ISA (Individual Student Account). Checks should be made payable to "LHS Band." **Orders and money are due no later than February 3**. Turn them in to the box labeled "Band Frozen Food and Jewelry Orders" on the north filing cabinets in the band room.

Please make certain that your name and phone number are on the order forms and envelopes. Check that the catalog item number has the correct dollar amount written on the order form. **WE MUST**

ADD TAX FOR ALL ITEMS AS SHOWN ON THE SHEETS INCLUDED IN THE SALES ENVELOPE.
Use the green and white tax price sheets, NOT the prices printed in the catalog. Staple the price sheets onto the catalog covers for easy reference or write the total cost by each item in the catalogs. Verify that the money collected equals the total sales.

Prizes will be awarded to the top two sellers. The student who sells the most (minimum of 15 items) will receive \$40. The second place seller (minimum of 15 items) will receive \$20.

The Seroogy's **chocolate and coffee fundraiser began Tuesday, January 21.** Order forms were handed out during band periods. Forms will also be available in the band room for students who do not have a band period.

Students earn 35% of their chocolate sales and 30% of their coffee sales for their ISA. Checks should be made payable to "LHS Band." **Orders and money are due no later than February 3.** Turn them in to the box on the north filing cabinets in the band room.

Please make certain that your name and phone number are on the order form and envelope. Verify that the money collected equals the total sales.

The delivery date is February 18. Students should **pick up their frozen food, jewelry, and Seroogy's orders on February 18 between 3:15-5:30 pm in the LHS cafeteria.**
