Students will earn 25% of their sales for their ISA.

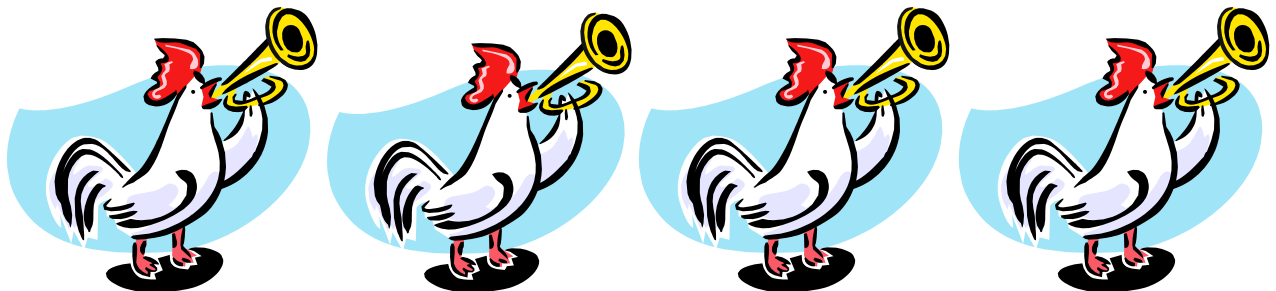

### **Uniform Check-in Dates:**

Uniform check-in will be Friday, November 14<sup>th</sup> from 3:45pm -7:00pm and Saturday, November 15<sup>th</sup> from 9:00am - 1:00pm in the band room. **PLEASE NOTE that these will be the only two days for uniform check-in so it is important that you make it on one of those two dates.** You may make arrangements for another student or parent to turn in your uniform, if you can't make either of those two times. If that won't work, please contact any of the uniform committee members to arrange an alternate time to drop off your uniform. **Uniforms MUST be dry cleaned, including the gauntlets (which is new this year).** Reed players, don't forget to check your pockets for any reeds before you dry-clean your uniform. **You also must bring the dry cleaning receipt with you to check in or you will be charged for another cleaning.** Dakota Dry Cleaners on 57th & Cliff is offering a 20% discount to LHS band members.

The uniform committee recommends that all uniforms be taken to Dakota Dry Cleaners on S. Cliff Ave. for cleaning **after the indoor shows.** The uniform committee has had to dry clean a few uniforms already and came across an issue. On some uniforms, the blue wing on the shoulders develops black spots that have to be spot treated to remove these spots. This is not happening on all uniforms. Dakota Dry Cleaners is aware of this issue and will watch for the spots. They will not charge extra for the spot removal. If you choose to go to another dry cleaner, be aware the uniform committee will not accept uniforms until these spots are removed. We would recommend you double check the shoulder wings before you leave the dry cleaner to make sure there are no black spots.

**As a reminder, the band is in full uniform for Chicken Dinner so uniforms should be dry cleaned after the Chicken Dinner performances.**

## **Uniform Check-In**

Friday, November 14, 3:45-7:00 and Saturday, November 15, 9:00-1:00 in the band room:

### WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

1. Look over the uniform. Make sure all buttons and snaps are securely sewn on. Empty all pockets.
2. Dry Clean the black pants, and the blue jacket. Tuba players **must also dry clean black berets**. The gauntlets must also be dry cleaned (don't forget to bring in the receipt). Reassemble the full uniform onto the blue hanger that was issued with the uniform.
3. Check your hat box. The hat box must include the hat and 2 gauntlets (except percussion). Tuba players will only have gauntlets and cleaned berets.
4. Gently wash the garment bag, and hang to dry. DO NOT put the garment bags in the washer or dryer.
5. Drill Master Shoes do not need to be returned, as they are personal property. However, shoe donations from Seniors (or growing feet) are welcome and appreciated at this time.
6. All additional uniform parts that have been borrowed from chaperones must also be cleaned and returned at this time, or ISA's will be charged for replacement costs.
7. Turn in your entire uniform and all accessories at one of the times listed above. If you were issued 2 uniforms, all parts from all uniforms must be cleaned and returned at this time.

### VOLUNTEER HELP NEEDED

- Every student will return their uniform within 2 days! We rely on volunteer help to make this run as efficiently as possible. Please consider volunteering for one (or both) of the check-ins.
