**Red, White & Blue** donations directly benefit LHS activities 100%.

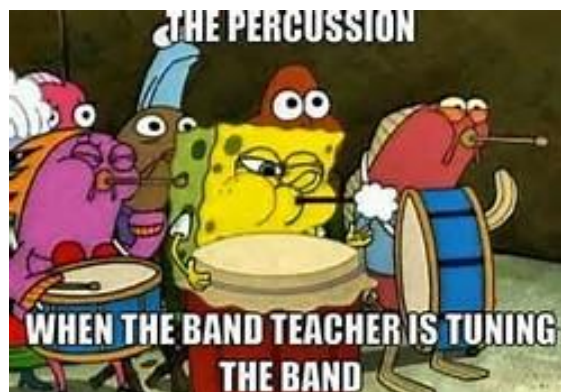
