#### Treasurer's Report by Stephanie Gongopoulos

- Have paid out 28% of expenses.
- Check has not cleared for Students on Broadway. Stephanie communicating with them on this.
- Have made about \$4500 in interest in Vanguard account.
- Covered September payments made.
- Currently over FDIC limit, but large checks to Students on Broadway and HyVee should be clearing account and take account back to under.
