

HAVE YOU EVER WONDERED?

Do you have questions about working any of the wonderful opportunities the LHS Marching Band offers? This information piece aims to answer questions that most people, new or veteran, may have.

1. THE DENNY SANFORD PREMIER CENTER (SIOUX FALLS ARENA AND CANARIES GAMES)

- a. **Type of Work:** Cashiers and food service at permanent booths and mobile kiosks
- b. **Age Requirement:** Students age 16 and up may sign up to work on their own. Parents may work too. The Denny has graciously allowed our 14 and 15 year olds to work **AS LONG AS** their parent and/or guardian feel they are responsible and ready to work **AND** they are working alongside a parent and/or guardian. This is a wonderful allowance by the Denny – and one we don't want to abuse.
- c. **Pay:** \$45/shift (minimum – the amount could be more depending on sales). Shifts are typically 5 hours (can be longer–depends on the event) 100% of the money is directed to the named student's ISA. 100% of tips are earmarked for budget line items of the Band Parents Association.
- d. **Dress Code:** Black pants, closed toe shoes (as per SD Health Regulations) and the bands Show Shirt.

2. THE SIOUX FALLS CONVENTION CENTER BANQUETS

- a. **Type of Work:** Food servers and room clean-up
- b. **Age Requirement:** Students age 15 and up may sign up to work on their own. Parents may work too. The supervisor has also allowed 14 year olds to work as long as they are responsible and are working alongside their parent and/or guardian.
- c. **Pay:** \$12/hour. 100% of the money is directed to the named student's ISA.
- d. **Dress Code:** Black pants, closed toe shoes (as per SD Health Regulations) and a black long-sleeved button shirt. NOTE: If you do not have a black long-sleeved button shirt, one will be provided for you.

3. OMEGAQUANT

- a. **Type of Work:** Seated assembly-line type work
- b. **Age Requirements:** Students age 15 and up may sign up to work on their own. Parents may work too. OmegaQuant has also allowed our younger 14 year olds to work as long as they are with a parent and/or guardian.
- c. **Pay:** \$10/hour. Shifts are typically 2 hours in length and 100% of the earned money goes directly into the named student's ISA.
- d. **Dress Code:** This is very informal as the work is done in the basement of their facility. Shorts/pants, t-shirt and tennis shoes are fine.

WHERE DO I GO?

When working the **Denny or Sioux Falls Convention Center:** Park in the Employee Parking: Lot E. Located behind or north of the Denny just east of Howard Wood Field. Enter through the door marked "Employee Entrance." Once inside a "Denny Employee" will be there to give you a wristband; which enables you to proceed to your assigned work area, i.e., through security and up to the concessions or behind the scenes to the banquet rooms. When working the Arena, parking is the same, but entrance is a bit different – please refer to attached map.

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO NEXT?


Upon arriving at your work station, make sure that you locate the "Sign In" Sheet designated for the LHS Band. You need to sign in AND out. Please indicate, on the signup sheet, which student's account you are working. At the end of the shift, ensure that someone from LHS takes a picture of the completed sign up and texts it to the number you've been given. FINALLY, be sure to have fun, work hard and represent the Lincoln Marching Patriot Band proudly.

WORKING THE CANARIES GAMES.....

Working at the Birdcage is just a little bit different than the Denny. So if you have signed up for Canaries Baseball – the information you need is below.

1. **Type of Work:** Cashiers and food service at permanent booths and mobile kiosks
2. **Age Requirement:** Workers need to be 16 years old to work. 14 and 15 year olds may work AS LONG AS THEY ARE WORKING WITH THEIR PARENT AND/OR GUARDIAN.
3. **Pay:** Pay is \$45 per person working. This is based on a 6.5 hour shift (break will be given to eat)
4. **Dress Code:** Dress code is either black or khaki jeans, shorts or capris. (**NO** short shorts). Shoes need to be closed toe as in tennis shoes (No flip flops, sandals, or backless shoes). Shirts will be either plain blue or yellow (Canaries colors) or our Band's Show Shirt.
5. **Where to Park:** You will want to park on the west side of the stadium. If you want to stay out of the foul ball range, I suggest parking closer to the road between the Stadium and the Premier Center, just to avoid having car windows hit with balls.
6. **Where to Check In:** You will need to check in and out with Kaitlin in the main concession stand (Hotdog Nation/Angus Nation). She will have a sign in sheet next to her office in the middle of the stand.
7. **Cell Phone Use:** Cell phones may be used outside of the stand by parents to check on kids at home. No cell phone use allowed inside the stands. All workers will need to check with the stand manager before leaving the stand to use cell phones.
8. **Clean Up:** At the end of the night cleanup will be checked and dismissed by the stand manager. All stands will be cleaned and restocked for the next day unless it is the last game of the home stand.
9. **Workers will be sent home early if stands are slow.** This will not affect the pay of the workers for the day.
10. **If selling beer the customer is only allowed to walk away from the window with 2 drinks at a time.** They can buy as many as they want but will need someone to help carry. As with the Denny, only adults may pour and serve beer. Our 16 year old students may not help customer carry extra beer to their seats.
